The Snowcross World Cup begins at Northern Power Race Park, Michigan's premier snocross facility. Equipped with industry-leading snowmaking and grooming capabilities, the facility delivers consistent, world-class racing conditions regardless of natural snowfall.

Round 1 & 2 are conveniently scheduled the weekend following the ISOC National in Ironwood, Michigan, making it easy for teams already competing in North America to continue their trip. The Park is located just four hours from Ironwood and will be open to welcome teams traveling directly from the National.

There will be open practice on Tuesday and Wednesday, Media Day on Thursday, followed by World Cup racing on Friday and Saturday. These rounds are sanctioned by ISR Racing.

The Snowcross World Cup concludes with some springtime action in Sweden, where Rounds 3 & 4 will take place in May! The host venue has been narrowed to three finalist locations, with the final selection based on several key factors, including snow conditions, accessibility from Stockholm, and accommodations for teams and spectators. The official venue will be announced as soon as it is confirmed.

The event schedule will mirror the North American rounds, with open practice on Tuesday and Wednesday, Media Day on Thursday, and World Cup racing on Friday and Saturday.

The inaugural Snowcross World Cup will conclude with an awards banquet and celebration on Saturday evening featuring live music.
