



## **Northern Power Race Park - Camping Rules & Regulations**

### **Check-In & Check-Out**

When you arrive at the park, you will:

1. Purchase your weekend ticket for the event at the front gate.
  2. Go to the registration cabin to check in for camping, receive your camping sticker, and receive your camping wristbands. All members of your party must check in at the registration cabin and receive a wristband to camp.
- Load-in day for camping is Friday. Times for each event may vary and will be posted for that specific event (gate opening time).
  - Camping passes are valid Friday through Sunday. All vehicles must be removed from the property by 10 am on Sunday.

### **Quiet Hours**

- Quiet hours (Northern Power Race Park and Mancelona) are from 10 pm to 7 am.
  - Many residential properties surround Northern Power Race Park, please be respectful of our neighbors.
- Excessively loud music is not allowed.

### **Vehicles & Parking**

- Camps are to be set up in assigned campsites only.
  - General campsites: Each 30' x 40' campsite will be laid out and identified.
  - VIP campsites: Each VIP campsite is numbered and marked with t-posts. (VIP campsites blocked off with rope/fence are off limits).
- One (1) camper and one (1) small tent allowed per site.
  - If no camper, up to three (3) small tents or one (1) large tent are allowed.
- All vehicles must have a camping/vehicle pass.
- Absolutely no ATV's, UTV's, motorcycles, scooters, hoverboards, or golf carts are allowed in any spectator areas. All such vehicles will be required to park outside the spectating areas in the designated parking zone.



## **Age Requirements and Restrictions**

- Northern Power Race Park permits adult or family camping only. All patrons 6 & older are required to wear a wristband.
- No minors under the age of 18 will be permitted to camp without a parent or guardian present. Guests will be required to provide identification before entrance into the camping areas.

## **Pets**

- No pets or animals are allowed in the spectator area/grandstands. Pets and animals must be tied, caged or otherwise secured in the camping area and supervised at all times.
- Please clean up after your pets.
- Aggressive or uncontrolled pets or animals may result in removal from the park.

## **Fires, Fire Pits & Firewood**

- Bonfires and digging of fire pits are not allowed. Cooking fires are allowed but must be controlled and contained in a fire ring, above-ground fire pit, or similar, and cannot exceed the diameter of a burn barrel. All fires must be attended to and extinguished when you leave.
- Please do not throw bottles, cans, furniture or other foreign objects into your campfire. Charcoal residue is all that is to be left in campfires. Fires are never to be left unattended at any time.
- Firewood is not provided by Northern Power Race Park. The firewood stored at the park near the NPRP fire pits is strictly off limits; this area is under surveillance. There is a local company that provides firewood on Valley Rd.

## **Trash & Clean-up**

- Pack it in, pack it out - no garbage left behind.
- Use designated trash receptacles placed around the park.
- Leave the campsite cleaner than you found it.
- Dumping is not prohibited anywhere on the property.



## Generators

Generators are allowed at Northern Power Race Park, but please follow these guidelines to ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable experience.

- **Noise Consideration**
  - Use quiet/inverter style generators when possible.
  - If your generator is excessively loud, you may be asked to turn it off during quiet hours or limit use.
- **Proper Ventilation & Placement**
  - Never operate generators inside RVs, enclosed trailers, or near windows/vents.
  - Position the exhaust away from other campers, tents, and walkways.
  - Use a generator exhaust extension if needed to safely redirect fumes.
- **Fuel Safety**
  - Store fuel away from heat sources and living spaces.
  - No refueling while the generator is running.
- **Supervision & Shutoff**
  - Generator must be attended to while running and shut off when leaving the site for extended periods.
- **Respect Your Neighbors**
  - If a neighbor complains about noise or fumes, please work together to resolve the issue politely.
  - Repeated complaints may lead to limits on generator use.

## Prohibited Items:

- Fireworks of any kind are strictly prohibited.
- Personal or private drones of any kind are not allowed to be flown at Northern Power Race Park at any time.
- Operating any device that makes unnecessary noise is prohibited.

## Safety & Behavior

- The Northern Power Race Park Code of Conduct pertains to all those camping.
- No fighting, reckless behavior or excessive partying.
- Disorderly conduct will not be tolerated.
- Burnouts, pit racing, or reckless driving of any sort of vehicle in the camping area will not be tolerated and will result in removal from the park.



Northern Power Race Park management reserves the right to exercise its discretion in all these matters.

Security Personnel and/or Official Law Enforcement will remove violators of the above rules, regulations, or local laws from the park. In addition, entry wristbands will be confiscated, and no second wristband can be purchased. Once guests in violation of the above rules are ejected, they cannot return. No exceptions.
